

Dear Sir/ Madam

- Seminars regarding Anti cheating campaign will be held in various districts in 3 stages as follows –

1. Rally -- About 100 students will take part in a rally on the day of seminar at 8:30 a.m. Students will be holding boards with Anti Cheating slogans written on them. Two students ahead in the rally will be holding a banner which will be provided by P.S.E.B.

2. Seminar -- It will start at 10:30 a.m. and last for 2 hrs. Total 400 participants will take part in the seminar. About 100 students and 300 principals & teachers from various schools will be participants. District Coordinator will select one chief guest and inform the convener about it. Programme will start with recitation of a Shabad. Two resource persons will speak on the subject. There will be a prize distribution for the winning students (1st, 2nd, 3rd) in drawing & slogan competitions in the district. One folk dance Gidha or Bhangra will be the last item of the function. Refreshment will be arranged at district level but menu will be decided by the Board. Refreshment may either be sponsored or may be organized by district coordinator/ district manager/ P.S.E.B. official. This can be discussed over telephone in advance by district coordinator/ district manager. Banners for the seminar, prizes and mementoes will be either sponsored or arranged by P.S.E.B but district official will honor the chief guest and other dignitaries.

3. Exhibition – An exhibition of the slogans/ posters will be organized on the day of seminar. Posters/ slogans will be handed over to district coordinator in advance by P.S.E.B.

- District coordinators will prepare one schedule of the function and send it to the convener the earliest possible.
- Media -- For the coverage of the programme, press media / electronic media should be contacted at the district level.
- One person should be deputed for documentation of the programme at district. level.
- Photographer and videographer will be arranged at district level.
